By registering with Success Fury Netball Club you consent and agree to the following:

**MEMBERSHIP:**

- Members agree to pay registration fees as outlined on Player HQ prior to Fury Netball Club accepting any registration.
- Application for membership to Fury Netball Club are subject to a position being available in a team.
- All members must abide to the Netball WA Code of Conduct available here <https://wa.netball.com.au/policies-procedures>

**REFUNDS:**

- Once registered, a player may only receive a refund of fees for medical reasons if they have not taken the court to play. A medical certificate will need to be provided to the Club Secretary.

**GRADING:**

- Fury Netball Club will conduct grading of all players playing in under 11's and up. By registering with Fury Netball Club you acknowledge that junior players will be graded as detailed in our Grading Policy found here [https://www.furynetballclub.com/files/ugd/cecdb3\\_2ddd31dc06ee43cbaab61f06c4662f92.pdf](https://www.furynetballclub.com/files/ugd/cecdb3_2ddd31dc06ee43cbaab61f06c4662f92.pdf) Fury Netball Club reserve to right to paper grade an age group when it is deemed that a physical grading is impractical.
- Players are placed in a team in their age group by default. Players will only be placed in older age group teams at the club's discretion.
- Team placements are final once teams are selected.

**TRAINING:**

- All players are expected to attend weekly training. Training is between 60-90 min and punctually is expected.
- The coach and team manager (who are volunteers) will attempt to find a regular training time that best suits the majority of the team. Not everyone can be suited and we request that netball (as a team sport) be given priority over individual commitments.

**GAMES:**

- Once registered players are committed to the full season. Players may only withdraw for medical reasons. If a player needs to miss more than 2 games in a season this must be communicated to the coach/manager as soon as possible with as much advanced notice as possible.
- Players are expected to inform their coach within 48 hours of their unavailability for a game.
- Players are expected to be in full Fury Netball Club uniform for all competition matches.
- Players, parents, team officials and spectators are to always display good sportsmanship.
- Players, parents, team officials and spectators are to respect their coach who generously volunteer their time. This includes not questioning a coach's decision regarding a player's position or the amount of match time allocated to each player.
- Players, parents, team officials and spectators are to always respect the Umpires.

**DUTIES:**

- From time-to-time Success Netball Association will allocate duties to Fury Netball Club. All teams (players and parents) are expected to support the club with any duties that are allocated.

**COVID 19:**
